Directions:

- Retell Zeke's story in your own words.
- Then, use paper and crayons to draw your own ending, narrating what happens aloud.



Caregiver Tips

- Place the *Zeke's Story Ending* images where children can see them and discuss the ending.
- Have children retell the story using cardinal numbers (1st, 2nd) while pointing to the pictures.
- Encourage them to create their own endings like Zadie, Zeke, and Malik, drawing one picture each to show what happened.
