Zeke's Rock Collection

Materials:

- A variety of materials for making patterns (plastic, foam wood, buttons, bottle caps)
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Crayons or Markers
- Zeke's Rock Collection Activity Sheet

Directions:

- Set up 3 examples of patterns.
- Have the children say the pattern they see out loud with you.
- Allow them to make their own pattern with the variety of materials listed above.
- Complete **Zeke's Rock Collection Activity Sheet**.
- Make a pattern with colors that repeat in the same order again and again. Choose two or three colors for your pattern and color in the rocks.

Caregiver Tips

- Use everyday objects to create and rearrange patterns for more practice.
- Lead your child in clap or stomp patterns. Clap your hands or stomp your feet in simple patterns (e.g., clap, stomp, clap, stomp) and have your child repeat.
